

Steelville Plein Air 2021

Rules, Considerations, Expectations

- ❖ The 2021 Steelville Plein Air event is Monday, June 7 through Friday, June 11.
- ❖ All artwork needs to be done entirely on location “en plein air” (not from photographs) within the region or at the location of the event.
- ❖ No pets are allowed at any of the painting sites or venues.
- ❖ Artists are invited to paint in public areas but must not obstruct roadways, sidewalks, business entries, etc.
- ❖ All work must be checked in and **properly framed**, including a hanging wire, by the daily designated time.
- ❖ Only **one** painting/panel may be entered per event. No double or triple panels.
- ❖ All works must be for sale.
- ❖ Once a piece has been entered for judging, it may not be entered again.
- ❖ All artwork presented for judging may be photographed and reproduced for non-commercial promotion by the Steelville Arts Council.
- ❖ Artists are not allowed in the designated location during judging. Judging decisions are final.
- ❖ Monetary prizes will be awarded for the Purchase prize, as well as for First, Second and Third places.
- ❖ All winning artwork, with the exception of Purchase awards, will be auctioned in either a live or on-line venue. STARCO Commission will be 30%.
- ❖ All artists will have the opportunity to sell their plein air work and other works of their creation in person on Saturday, June 12 at the Community Center from 10:00 a.m to 3:00 p.m. Designated spaces and tables will be provided. Easels and walls for display are the responsibility of the artist. STARCO Commission for work sold is 30%. All sales will be handled by the Steelville Arts Council.
- ❖ Artists have the opportunity to exhibit their Steelville Plein Air work (not other work) at Gallery Zeke during the month of June 2021. On-line sales will also take place during this time. Artists are requested to link the on-line site to their web pages to promote their work. STARCO Commission for work sold is 30%. All sales will be handled by the Steelville Arts Council.
